We are all outraged by what is happening in Minneapolis/St Paul and the murder of US citizens by federal agents of ICE and Border Patrol. Groups are organizing popup demonstrations all week so watch for info from your sources. ***Here are some things you can do:***

- Join our No Concentration Camps Colorado coalition. <https://nocampscolorado.org/>
 - Join a Colorado Immigrant Partnership Team. We have 30 teams all over the state.
 - Join our Key Lime Airlines coalition - convincing Key Lime Airlines, based in Englewood, to drop their contract with ICE. (See more below.)

- Join our effort to convince CU to drop their contract with Key Lime Airlines.
 - Join our Colorado coalition to push other private companies who have contracts with ICE to drop those contracts. This includes companies like BI Inc, Palantir, etc.
 - [Check out this toolkit](#) developed by immigration activists in NC.
 - [Contribute to the American Friends Service Committee.](#)
 - Volunteer to help monitor state legislation in Colorado that is going to be introduced to further protect our immigrant neighbors.
 - Join a neighborhood watch group if you live close to an immigrant majority neighborhood or business district.
 - Volunteer to monitor whether or not SB 276 has been implemented in your community.
 - Join our teams to contact businesses to share Know Your Rights information.
 - Consider asking your city council or county commissioners to adopt a resolution similar to the one the Aurora City Council just adopted.
 - If you have a Republican Member of Congress, call them every day. It is despicable they voted for more funding for DHS.
 - **Call Senators Hickenlooper and Bennet!** They have come out against funding DHS but keep calling! [Use this link](#) to reach them and a script is available with ideas of what to say. You can also use 5calls.org to reach them. We're demanding Congress use the appropriations process to end ICE and Border Patrol's lawlessness.



👉 There is a citizen initiative, **Initiative 95**, that would amend the state constitution to require that police officers, sheriff's deputies and prosecutors alert federal immigration authorities if they charge someone whose immigration status is in question if that person has a prior felony conviction or the charge is for an alleged violent crime. If voters approve the measure, it would override existing state laws, passed by Democrats in the legislature, prohibiting Colorado law enforcement from working with federal immigration officers. 
